The Design/Build team of Cushing Terrell/Martel facilitated the Building Committee meeting.

The Design/Build team provided the committee with general information regarding the state of the school based on their assessments. In addition, they highlighted their findings regarding areas of concern and/or deficiency. The committee members were able to ask questions regarding their findings.

Superintendent Theresa Keel provided the committee with an overview of the demographics study conducted by McKibben.

District Clerk Carrie Fisher provided the committee with information regarding the District's current bonds outstanding and bonding capacity.

The Design/Build team presented information gathered from District teachers and staff. The team conducted an exercise with the committee to identify the committee's top 5 goals/vision for facility upgrades/renovations.

The committee reviewed the draft survey provided by the Design/Build team. The committee expressed that they would like the survey to reach all voters in the district to gain the most feedback about the priorities of the community. The Design/Build team will work with the administration to develop a plan to distribute the link for the online survey, so the committee can have that input prior to their July meeting.

The Design/Build team will present information regarding the Assessment Phase to the school Board on June 30, 2020. The next phase will be the Explore Phase.

The next committee meeting is scheduled for July 30, 2020 @ 6:30pm. If Board consensus is to move to the Explore Phase the Design/build team will provide the committee with some initial concept ideas based on committee and staff/teacher feedback and the community survey results.
