The committee discussed the format for a community open house on August 25, 2020 from 6:30-8pm. The committee also discussed another community survey to be sent out in conjunction with the community open house in an effort to get feedback regarding the design concepts presented at the open house.

The committee narrowed the concepts to 4. These concepts would include different levels of bond funding with the minimum being the baseline of \$3million and the highest concept amount to be \$7million. All open house attendees will be broken down into 4 groups of 25 or smaller and will rotate between sessions every 15 minutes. Committee members will be paired with each design/build team member to present the concepts.
