## Gallatin Gateway School Building Committee

The Design/Build team of Cushing Terrell/Martel facilitated the Building Committee meeting.

The committee reviewed the community survey feedback and discussed feedback received at the August 25, 2020 community open house. The consensus was that the committee would like the Design/build team to provide more information and refine the designs for the 1914 restoration and replacement concepts at the full \$7million bond amount.

In addition, the committee asked the Design/build team to isolate the cost of the 1914 restoration as a % of the total project cost, provide elevation drawings for both concepts, and determine the potential cost for adding a second floor (unfinished) to the replacement concept.

The committee talked about the importance of ensuring all of the deferred maintenance issues be addressed, but to also ensure the District is prepared to address any growth that may occur in the future.

Public comment was received from: Jason Fleury and Julie Fleury.

Future committee meeting date/time was scheduled for September 23, 2020 at 6:30 to determine the committee's recommendation to the Board. The committee will also ask the Board to hold a special meeting the week of Sept. 28 to consider the recommendation. .
