### **Minutes:**

1. Meeting was called to order at 5:35 PM
2. Public Comment Non-Agenda Items: None.
3. Alec and Bryan shared a brief review of their recent Monforton building project. They are currently at capacity with the latest building project.
4. The first Monforton Growth study was completed 2007, the second one in 2012.
5. Monforton School financed their growth study using voluntary impact fees from developers. They continue to receive voluntary impact fees for every lot that is sold and developed.
6. The first growth study did not keep up with the actual growth, prompting the second growth study.
7. The two Monforton building expansions increased the previous student capacity by approximately 100%.
8. Monforton implemented an organized campaign to educate the community on the issues, proposed solution and cost to accommodate the student overcrowding in the Monforton School.
9. Monforton needed to use their original building to accommodate the student numbers before the completion of the building expansions.
10. Four Corners had several subdivisions approved by the county commission. The increase in building projects on the approved lots began after the completion of the Four Corners water and sewer system.
11. Alec and Bryan advised that GG have a plan for out-of-district students and meet with developers in the beginning to create a growth vision that works for the school, community and developers.
12. Next meeting date to be determined by the schedule of the December guest speaker.


